CONSIDERATION OF AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY CODE CHAPTER 110 (RELATING TO LIQUOR LICENSING)

Notice is hereby given that the following amendment to the City's Liquor Ordinance (City Code Chapter 110) will be considered at the regular City Council meeting on Monday, April 17, 2023. This amendment was introduced at the regular Council meeting on February 21, 2023, when its "first reading" was approved by the City Council.

The public will have the opportunity to address the Council (either in favor or opposition) regarding this amendment prior to the Council's vote on April 17th. The proposed amendment is as follows:

<p>Ordinance No. 2023-01</p> <p>An Ordinance Amending Parkers Prairie City Code Chapter 110, § 110.06 Relating to Liquor Licensing</p> <p>WHEREAS, Section 110.06(K) (6) of the City Code for the City of Parkers Prairie, Minnesota prohibits the issuance of a liquor license for a premises within 500 feet of any school or place of worship; and</p> <p>WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that a restriction of at least 300 feet from any school or place of worship would better serve the public interest.</p> <p>NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council for the City of Parkers Prairie, Minnesota hereby ordains that Parkers Prairie City Code § 110.06(K) (6) shall be and hereby is amended as follows:</p> <p>No license shall be granted within 300 feet of any school or place of worship.
